Process of Decision Making

Introduction

The Chancellor, and through the Chancellor, the Board of Trustees, has numerous committees, councils, and other groups who provide advice, recommendations, and/or formal proposals related to Policies and Procedures. This participatory governance structure provides the Chancellor with advice and recommendations, but it is the Chancellor who has the responsibility for deciding on the route a proposal will take, and for its final disposition. A description of this existing governance procedure follows:

Board Policy & Procedures

- Existing Policies & Procedures appear in the Board Policy and Procedures Manual with dates of adoption/approval. These Policies and Procedures, in large measure, govern the operation of the Kern Community College District. The Chancellor's role and responsibilities provide wide latitude for decision making, and the Chancellor's Office makes many decisions on a daily basis within the framework of decision making described in this document, and in the accompanying chart.
- Policies are concerned with broad directions for the administration of the District as specified by the Education Code, Title 5 Provisions, and other legal agencies. Policies are adopted by the Board of Trustees.
- Procedures are concerned with the details of the administration of policies adopted by the Board of Trustees, or Title 5 Provisions adopted by the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges. Procedures are approved by the Chancellor of the District after appropriate consideration by the Chancellor's Executive Council, and also by the Chancellor's Cabinet, when referred to that body by the Chancellor.
- Amendments to board policies and procedures, or the creation of new
 policies or procedures, may be originated by District-wide Committees,
 Councils of the Colleges, Academic Senates, Associated Student
 Organizations, other recognized groups, and administrators working under
 the direction of the Chancellor.
- Amendments to board policies and procedures, or the creation of new
 policies and procedures, originated by any of the groups or individuals
 noted above are referred first to the Chancellor of the District who may
 direct them for further study to existing committees of the District or the
 Colleges, or the Chancellor may refer these proposed amendments to the
 Chancellor's Executive Council for consideration.

- The Chancellor's Executive Council is the clearing house for the consideration of all proposals for creation of or amendment of Board Policies and Procedures. The Executive Council, after due research and consideration, makes its recommendations to the Chancellor.
- The Chancellor may refer the proposed changes in policy or procedures recommended by the Executive Council to the Chancellor's Cabinet for further consideration, and for recommendations from this body. The Chancellor, in consideration of proposals, takes into account whether the subject under consideration is governed by a union agreement or by "reliance primarily on the judgment of the Academic Senate", or "reliance on mutual agreement" with the Academic Senate.
- With respect to Board Policies, following Chancellor's Cabinet considerations and recommendations, the Chancellor may recommend the proposed changes to the Board of Trustees for adoption. Once adopted, these Policies are incorporated into the Board Policies and Procedures Manual.
- With respect to Procedures, it is the Chancellor's responsibility to consider
 the advice and recommendations of the Chancellor's Executive Council
 and Chancellor's Cabinet, and to give final approval to these procedures
 prior to incorporation into the Board Policies and Procedures Manual.
 This may include presenting the matter to the Chancellor's Cabinet as
 deemed appropriate by the Chancellor.

District-wide Committees


There are currently fourteen (14) District-wide Committees that the Chancellor depends on for advice and recommendations in the governance process. The history, purposes, composition, and frequency of meetings of these 14 Committees are a matter of record in the Chancellor's Office. The Chancellor designates the Chair of these Committees. Membership on the Committees is described under composition, and in all instances includes representations from the Colleges and the District.

With respect to decisions having District-wide application, the District-wide Committees channel their suggestions and/or recommendation to the Chancellor for consideration and disposition.

With respect to procedural matters within the purposes of the respective Committees, the District-wide Committees have latitude for decision-making.

Collective Bargaining Agreements

Collective Bargaining agreements arrived at through negotiations with the respective recognized employee groups are governed by statutes and memoranda of agreement. These agreements, once arrived at, are taken to the Board of Trustees for approval. These agreements are within the scope of collective bargaining as determined by Legislative statutes, and are binding as they relate to governance.
