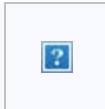

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Hi Corey and Chad,

FYI, I'm forwarding you what was sent to Kim Kelly yesterday for her research request. Andy and I had a few separate conversations regarding the limitations to pulling athletics data (as well as to the of the specific challenges to pulling what Kim was requesting). Accurately tracking our student athletes is definitely an area IR plans to look into.

At the last District IR meeting, the teams had a discussion regarding some of the existing practices of properly coding our student athletes and having appropriate Banner forms to capture our active and inactive athletes (e.g. SGASPORT and SGRSPORT). The other schools are open to sharing their best practices and any existing tools with us. This particular topic will be an added component of a larger discussion around data collection and disaggregation that we're planning to have with stakeholders at our campus before the semester is over. These changes won't occur overnight, but I'm confident we'll make some significant progress by this time next year.
