





New Student Matriculation Checklist

Step 1)	Complete Admissions Application
Step 2)	Orientation – Part I & II (below)
Step 3)	Placement Assessment

Orientation - Part I: (Handout and go over with student)

Matriculation is Orientation/Placement/Counseling (once all three components are completed students will begin to receive priority registration status for future semesters)

Full-time status is 12 units or more

Fees are \$46 per unit – students have 10 days to pay fees or will be dropped for non-payment

It is a student's responsibility to add and/or drop their courses! *Important drops dates*: Drop by the 10% date, last day to request a refund. Drop by the 20% date, no entry placed on transcript. Drop by the 60% date, student will receive a W (withdrawal) on transcript. After the 60% date, student will receive the grade earned in the course. Students can check course syllabus for when these dates occur.
