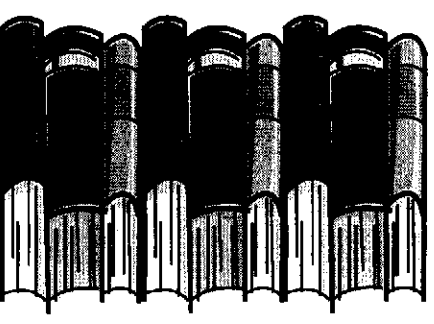

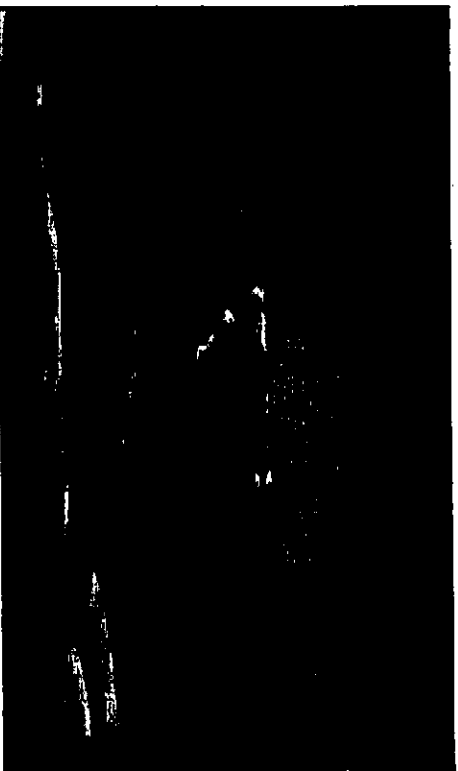

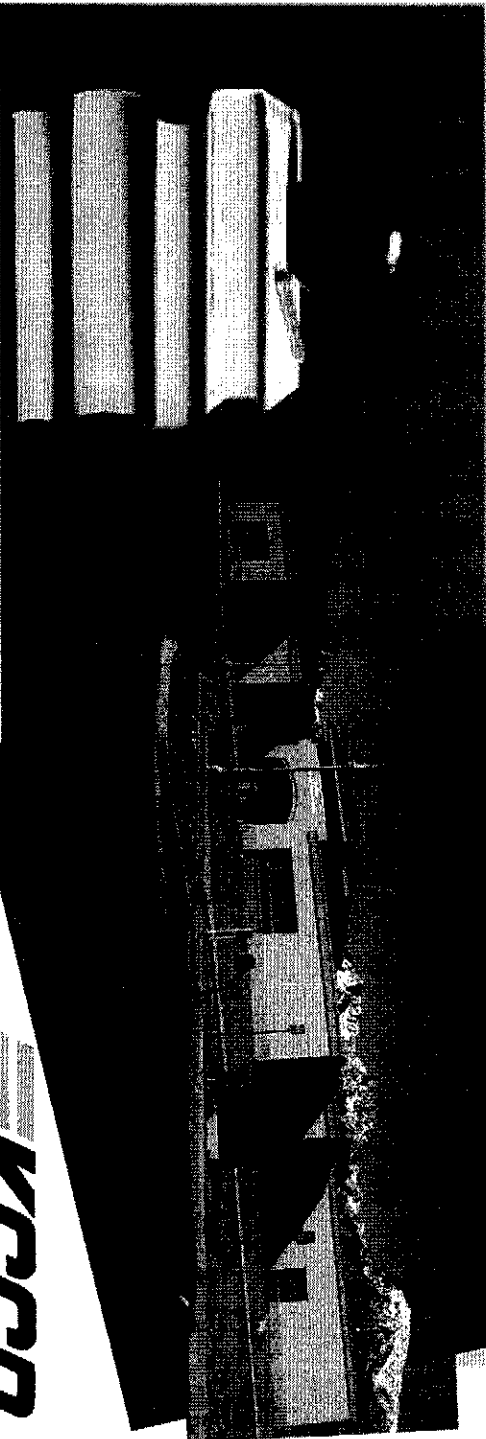

  - All new students must complete an online Admissions form
  - All returning & continuing students must complete an online Update form
  
- 3. Assessment Testing / LRC Information**
  - All students enrolling in Math/English must take an assessment test
  - Students may meet with a counselor to determine if past courses meet requirements
  
- 4. Educational Advising & Veteran's Affairs / Counseling - New**
  - New students must meet with a counselor or educational advisor to develop an Educational Plan
  - Veterans may meet with an educational advisor about eligibility for Veterans Programs
  
- 5. Educational Advising / Counseling - Continuing Students**
  - Continuing & Returning students should meet with a counselor to update their Educational Plan
  
- 6. Financial Aid Assistance / Scholarship Information**
  - Students seeking financial assistance should meet with the Financial Aid Director
  
- 7. Registration & Bookstore**
  - Students with Priority Registration may register and pay for classes
  - Students without Priority Registration may learn how to register and pay online

## **New Student Matriculation Checklist**

- Step 1) Complete Admissions Application
- Step 2) Orientation – Part I & II (below)
- Step 3) Placement Assessment
- Step 4) Counseling – Student Educational Planning
- Step 5) Class Registration

### **Orientation - Part I: (Handout and go over with student)**

Matriculation is Orientation/Placement/Counseling (once all three components are completed students will begin to receive priority registration status for future semesters)

Full-time status is 12 units or more

Fees are \$46 per unit – students have 10 days to pay fees or will be dropped for non-payment

It is a student's responsibility to add and/or drop their courses!

*Important drops dates:* Drop by the 10% date, last day to request a refund. Drop by the 20% date, no entry placed on transcript. Drop by the 60% date, student will receive a W (withdrawal) on transcript. After the 60% date, student will receive the grade earned in the course. Students can check course syllabus for when these dates occur.
