Eligibility:

Students must possess and maintain:

Benefits:

The college will provide a \$250.00 stipend per semester to each Student Ambassador who has fulfilled his/her obligation to the college and program. If the budget allows the Ambassadors will also be provided a college shirt and/or sweatshirt to be worn to events at which they are representing Cerro Coso. Additional benefits include:

- Opportunity to further develop leadership skills
- Extracurricular activities to report on college and scholarship applications
- Development of skills that will transfer to other employment opportunities
