Designed for both full and part-time students, this program is appropriate to both those currently employed and those seeking to enter this field.	There has been an increasing need in our service area, state and across the country for qualified entry level personnel to enter the CyberSecurity, Information Assurance and general Information Technology/Networking Technology fields. This need continues to expand as the networks and systems in major organizations are infiltrated by hackers and hostile groups. The Information Technology Plus Certificate of Achievement will provide students with a baseline of courses to be immediately employed in CyberSecurity, Information Assurance, Computer Repair, Computer Networking or Computer Operator.
