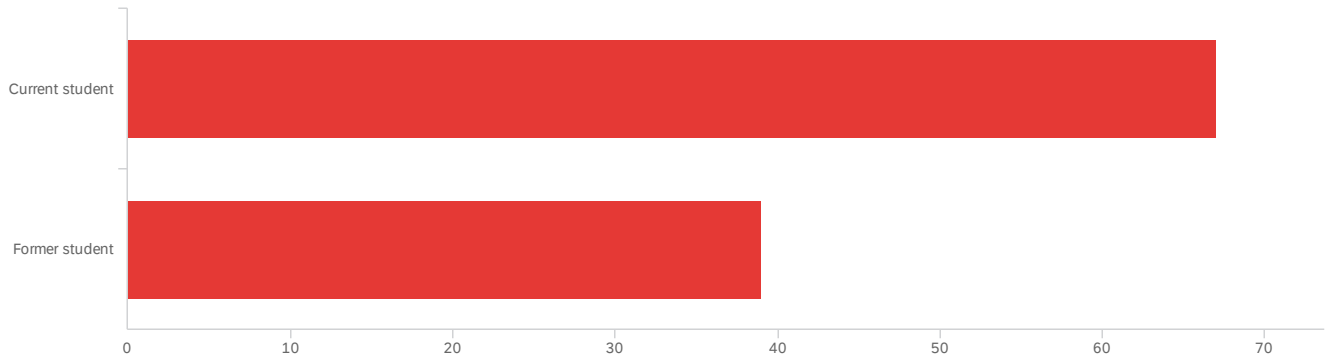

Q1 - Are you a current or former student at Cerro Coso Community College?



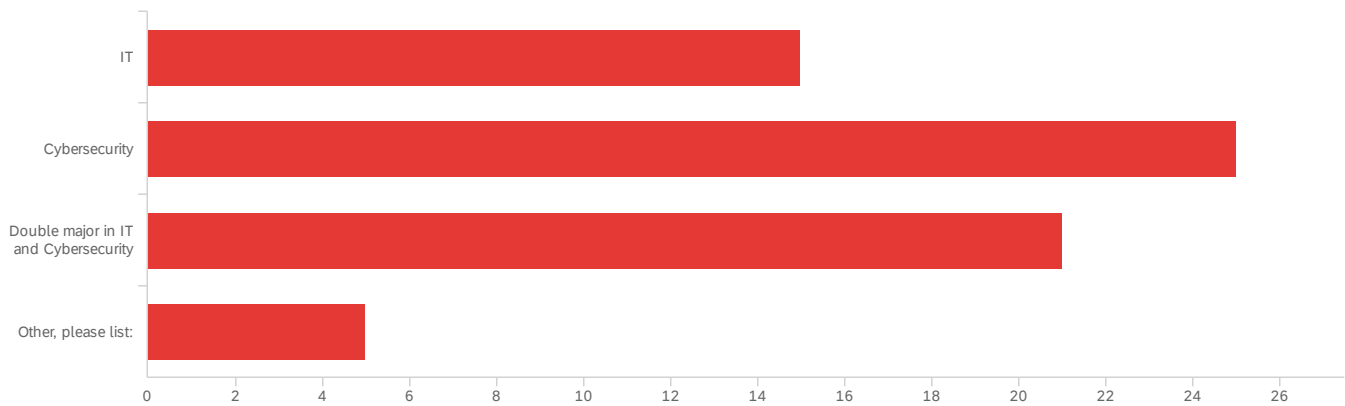

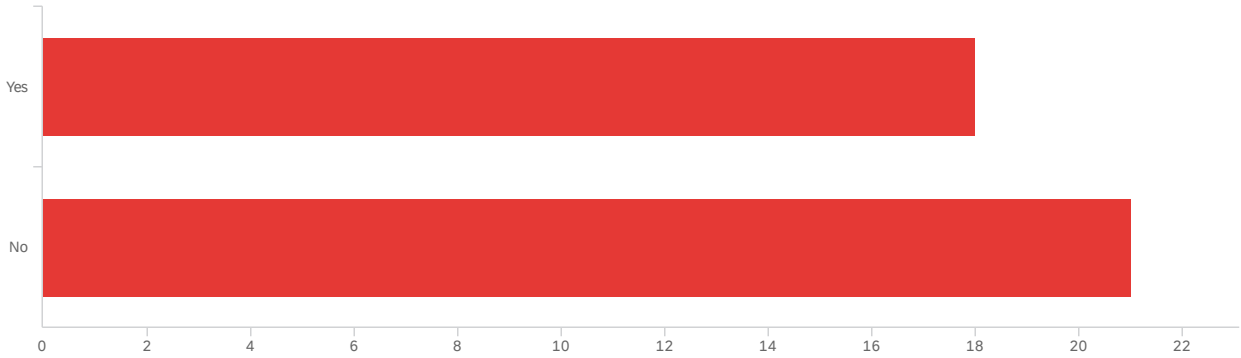

Q3 - Did you earn a degree or certificate in either the IT or Cybersecurity program at Cerro Coso?



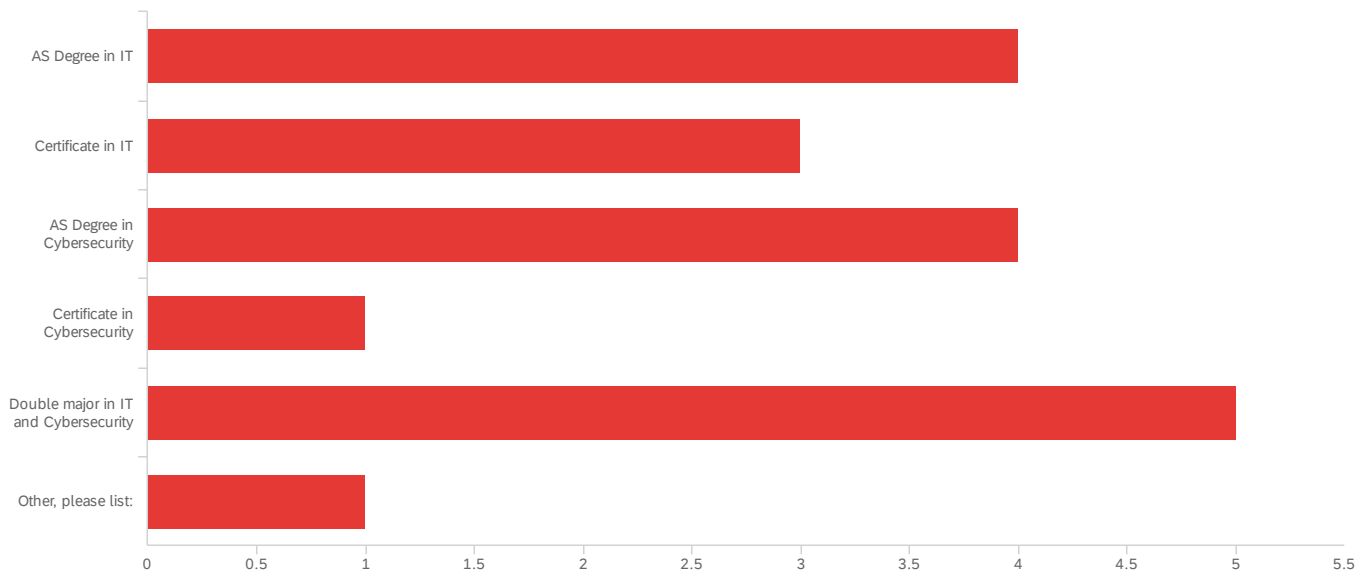

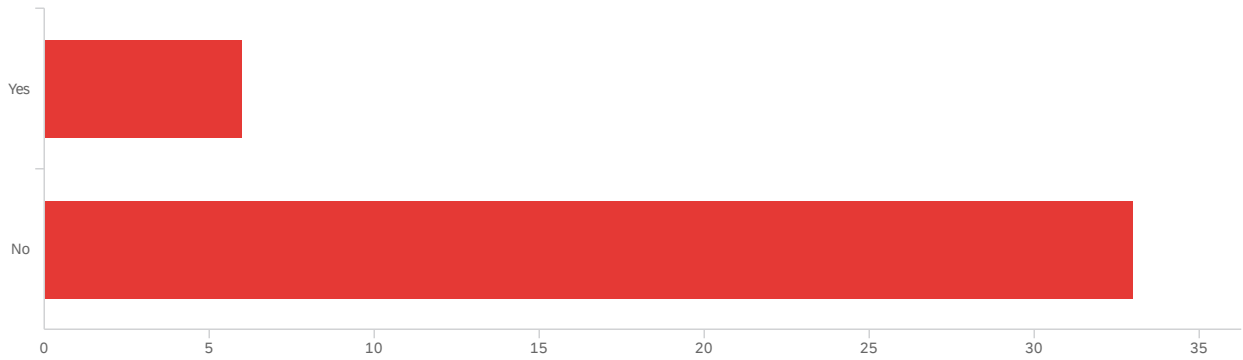

Q5 - Did you earn or are currently pursuing a Bachelor Degree in IT or Cybersecurity at a four-year institution?



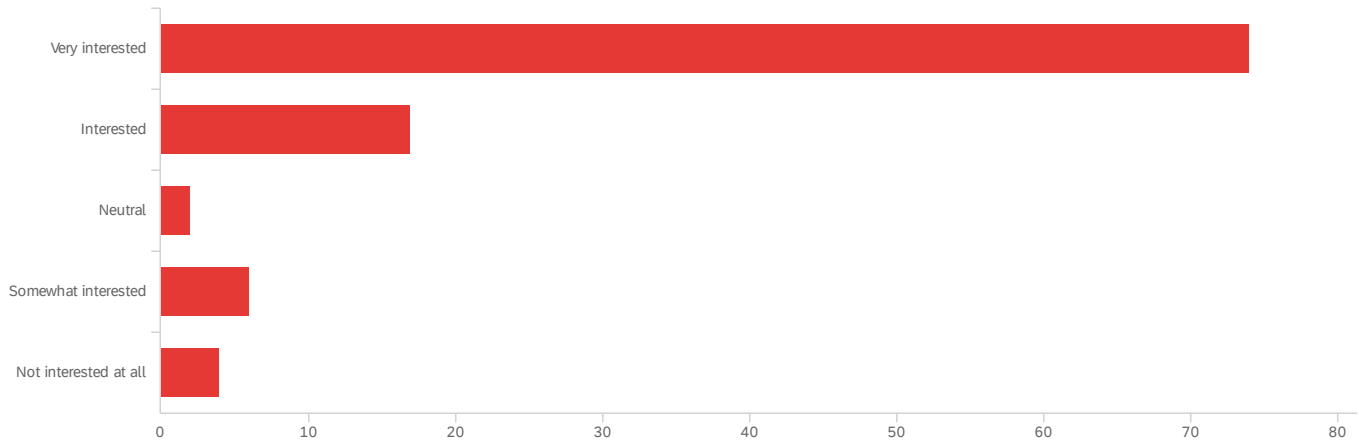
