

# Annual Median Earnings for Workers Aged 22-27


On an annual basis, bachelor's degree holders earn about \$32,000 more than those with only a high school diploma.



#### Associate Degrees for Transfer

Associate in Arts Degrees for Transfer (AA-T) and Associate in Science Degrees for Transfer (AS-T) provide you with a clear pathway to a baccalaureate degree. Earning an AA-T or AS-T guarantees acceptance to many four-year universities with junior standing and prepares you to complete a bachelor degree in a similar major at a CSU or a participating UC, HBCU or private university.

#### Associate in Arts Degrees

Associate in Arts degrees (AA) are general studies degrees that you can use to prepare for a major at a four-year university.

#### **Associate in Science Degrees**

Associate in Science degrees (AS) can be used to obtain necessary skills to enter the workforce and start a career or they may be used to prepare for a major at a four-year university to further enhance your employability.

#### Certificates of Achievement

Certificates of Achievement prepare you to enter a specific field of endeavor, typically a career field with prospects of employment, or enhance your skills for advancement in your job.

# After you submit your application

Once you have received your FAFSA Submission Summary and it is correct, check your Cerro Coso InsideCC account for all updates and student requirements.

Check your Cerro Coso student-assigned email regularly and remember your password.

Verification - School requesting more information (example: income taxes)

The FAFSA creates an SAI or Student Aid Index. This amount is used to determine financial need.

The FAFSA reflects the family finances from two-year-old taxes. If your circumstances have changed, contact the financial aid office. They can help you increase your eligibility.

- Must complete Math/English within the first year for either the current or upcoming term.
- Strongly recommend that students take a LIBR course with English classes.
- Strongly recommend that students take counseling courses within their first year

## MAMMOTH LAKES/EASTERN SIERRA FOUNDATIONS

#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Be a Inyo/Mono County Resident for the past one year or be a Inyo/Mono County High School Graduate.

Students must complete and submit a financial aid application and provide proof of submission: FAFSA or CA Dream Act.

Students must apply for Cerro Coso's Extended Opportunity Program and Services (EOPS)

Complete matriculation services at Cerro Coso (Assessment, Orientation, Counseling and Education Plan) and provide proof of completion.

Hold on-ground full-time student status (12+ units) at ESCC Campuses for applying semester.

Applicant must write a brief, typed, minimum 250-word statement letter.

Commit to and complete volunteer service & check in with learning resource center weekly.

Must reapply each semester & maintain 2.5 GPA.
