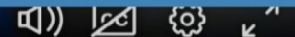

Graduation Requirements

Whether your goal is to earn a degree for transfer or a technical degree for more immediate employment, you'll leave Cerro Coso as a graduate when you:

- Complete a total of 60 degree-applicable units
- Earn at least 12 units here at Cerro Coso
- Meet both general education and major requirements for your chosen degree
- Earn a cumulative GPA of 2.0 with a grade of "C" or better in math, English, and major courses
- Make an appointment with a counselor to complete a graduation evaluation and submit a Petition to Graduate.
