BC Dean of Instruction, Cindy Collier, who is lead on this matter, explained to the two groups that there will be no penalty for faculty and staff if they smoke on campus. There will be an educational component to aid BC smokers with cession. Both presidents of CCA and Academic Senate have concerns for possible penalties for students only based on their Code of Conduct language and the procedure not having "teeth" in order to gain compliance from all.	x
