E-Sports popularity during COVID-19 has grown rapidly at colleges. Student Services has looked closely during the last year at what that would look like for Cerro Coso. It was noted that John McHenry has added E-Sports to his Annual Unit Plan. Groundwork has been laid and will continue to be investigated. There is currently a student club, Game On, that could introduce gaming competitions to reinvigorate the students and would be a great place to start. It was agreed that a step-by-step process to add late students would need to be identified. It was noted that Cerro Coso runs late adds very different than the other two colleges so this will make a difference and will need to be addressed. President Hancock will request further information form District Office IT on the Banner 9 implementation and share with College Council. It was recommended that a representative from Admissions & Records attend College Council and provide an overview of the late add process. If we migrate to Baseline Banner 9, this will be a moot point.
