



CSUB TRANSFER STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Students must meet the following for Upper-Division transfer:

1. Completion of 4 Basic Skills Requirements with a "C" or higher:

- A1. Oral Communication**
- A2. Written Communication
- A3. Critical Thinking
- B4. Mathematics/Quantitative Reasoning

Note: The above requirements can also be met through Advanced Placement or CLEP tests.

2. Complete a minimum of 60 CSU transferable semester units

3. Minimum 2.0 Grade Point Average

Applicants who have completed fewer than 60 transferable semester units are considered Lower-Division transfers. They must submit high school transcripts and test scores to meet the freshman admission requirements according to the year they graduated from high school.
