4. eLumen Update	Vivian Baker	Update	Data has been scraped from Curricunet and will be entered into eLumen, then we'll review course by course. We still need a district wide solution for our SLO assessments currently stored in Curricunet. Sounds like the district is going to pay for access to Curricunet for another year – in negotiations. *If Senate isn't ready to move to a 3 or 4 level Mastery rubric, can we move forward on yes/no (current rubric) and reflect/adapt later? (Vivian will check with eLumen).

Student Learning Outcome Assessment Committee Themes Program/Unit review of AUP (Report)	Vivian Baker	Review Report	Review the list of themes – they were updates last year, are they still working, and are we capturing the information we need? The numbers have continually changed, some quite a bit (Need to alter/refine instructional technique 18 (in 2012) to 3 (in2016), however, because LO may not be assessed every year, this data could be somewhat misleading. *Some AUO report nothing in this area, and it's not clear how many/if any Learning Outcomes were assessed/reviewed in the year. We need to review the SLO gap information. Suggested adding: How many Learning Outcomes were assessed in the year, then report on any that had identified gaps. *See notes related to EOPS/CARE in the SLO Themes report (attached). COUN 101 – Jan will talk to Karee – should COUN 101 be

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			included in the AUO data? **Vivian needs to check if in elumen we can link data for COUN 101 to Access in AUO.
6. PLO reporting on the website	Corey Marvin	Discussion	PLO information is on the website under Program Degrees and Certifications “further information”. Corey will send out a write up on how to view them. This fulfills goal and accreditation obligation to have Learning Outcomes visible (They were previously visible through Curricunet with “guest access”). Link on the Program page to Program Review for further information. Suggest Programs consider providing information on who was counted in denominator (students who completed course, or only those who completed the program). *In elumen all SLO data will populate PLOs and can pull into Program Review.

SLO Symposium take-away	Vivian/Suzie/ Heather	Discussion	NILOA – LO assessment is trending towards less formal, and more meaningful. eLumen has a template area for reflections on the assessment and this is the portion that can be made available to share while (at the course level only the faculty member will see individual information). PR module has an area for text (narrative) and widgets. The day was good, but grueling. Corey stated there is money to support symposium attendance and overnight accommodations for future year.

2015 AUP LRC - new outcomes will be defined as libr and lac combine, survey questions will need to be revised. (no gap, just continued quality improvement). 2017: Access One Administrative Unit Outcome for Access Program "Outreach to increase overall number of Access Programs participants" this includes DSPS, EOPS/CARE, CalWORKs and the program requires EOPS/CARE participants to enroll in COUN C101 for which SLOs are assessed. It would seem the AUP should include disaggregated data to show EOPS/CARE student assessment in COUN C101 as it is a required course for program compliance and SLO data is collected.

2015 Themes were revised. 2014 included "need for tutoring", which is combined with "student unprepared in reading..."; "Need for additional faculty/staffing" and "Need for facilities/equip." was combined into "Limited capacity/infrastructure".
